Traffic Orders Notice 2024

The Norfolk County Council has made the following three Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on 30th April 2024 which come into operation on 4th May 2024 to have the effects as follows:-

The Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Heartsease Roundabout Scheme)
(20mph Speed Limit) Order 2024

to prohibit any vehicle from exceeding 20 miles per hour along the length of roads specified in the Schedule below:-

In the City of Norwich

20mph Zone

C874 Plumstead Road East	-	From its junction with Heartsease Roundabout for 63m north-eastwards
A1042 Heartsease Lane	-	From its junction with Heartsease Roundabout for 62m northwards
A1042 St Williams Way	-	From its junction with Heartsease Roundabout for 58m south-eastwards
C596 Harvey Lane	-	From its junction with Heartsease Roundabout for 55m southwards
B1140 Plumstead Road	-	From its junction with Heartsease Roundabout for 6m southwestwards
Heartsease Roundabout	-	For its entire circumference

to amend The Norfolk County Council (Thorpe St Andrew, Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Consolidation and Variation Order 2011 (hereinafter referred to as the “2011 Order”) as specified in the Schedule below:-

SCHEDULE
In the Town of Thorpe St Andrew

Remove the following references from Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order:-

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

A1042 St Williams Way (South Side)	-	From its junction with the C596 Harvey Lane south-eastwards to a point 50 metres north-west of its junction with the U59599 Margetson Avenue.
	-	From a point 36 metres north-west of the centreline of its junction with the U59599 Margetson Avenue south eastwards to a point 38 metres south-east of the centre line of its junction with the 59599 Margetson Avenue.

Insert the following reference into Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order:-

A1042 St Williams Way (South Side)	-	From its junction with the C596 Harvey Lane to a point 38 metres southeast of the centre line of its junction with the U59599 Margetson Avenue

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 30th April 2024 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
