

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Gertrude Road)  
Emergency Notice  
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024  
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Gertrude Road (CTRO955) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to subsidence repair the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Gertrude Road from its junction with Garrett Court for 20m westwards (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited.

The closure is necessary because of the likelihood or danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both and is anticipated to take place from 13th May to 2nd June 2024 or until the closure is no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works or when the closure is no longer necessary without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Alternative route is via: Gertrude Road, Lavengro Road, Mousehold Avenue, Silver Road, Sprowston Road and vice versa.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
