

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order affecting the 1) Heigham Road from its junction with Earlham Road for 15m northwards; and 2) Mill Hill Road from its junction with Earlham Road for 15m southwards; in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate emergency subsidence repair works on Earlham Road by Anglian Water.

This Order continue the provisions of the Order dated 22nd June 2024 that the roads 1) and 2) will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 5th to 26th July 2024 (previously 28th May to 5th July 2024).

Alternative route is via: 1) Earlham Road, Unthank Road, Convent Road, Grapes Hill, Dereham Road, Heigham Road and vice versa; and 2) Earlham Road, Park Lane, Mill Hill Road and vice versa.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

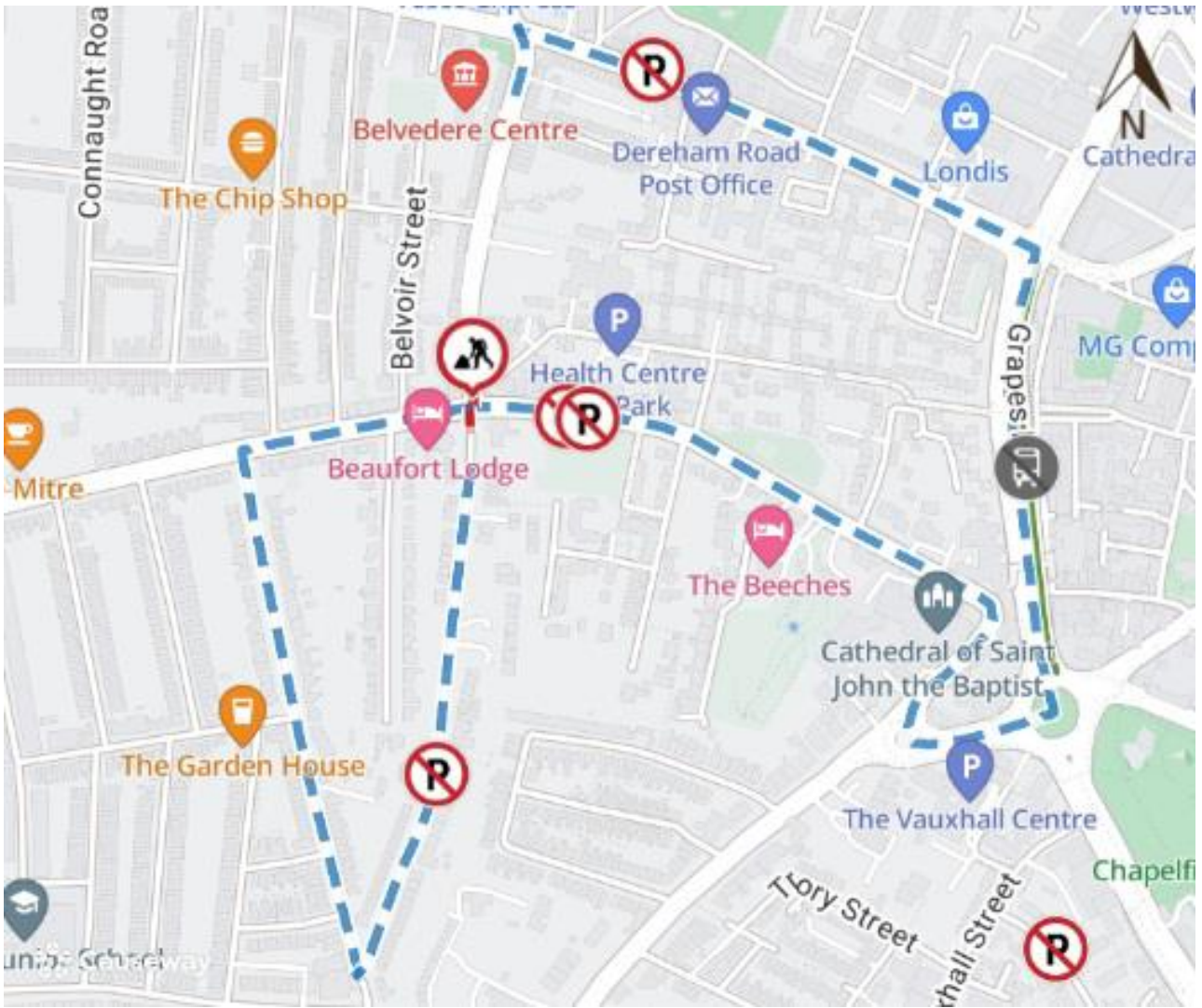
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
