

**The Norfolk County Council**  
**(Norwich, Southern Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting)**  
**(U42206 Christchurch Road) Amendment Traffic Regulation Order 2024**

The Norfolk County Council has made the above mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 which comes into operation on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2024, the effect of which is to amend The City of Norwich (Southern Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order, 1982 (as amended) to extend the existing, on the ground, No waiting At Any Time Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) at the junction with Earlham Road to an overall length of 38 metres. The order is amended as follows:-

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4 and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Southern Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (U42206 Christchurch Road) Amendment Traffic Regulation Order 2024 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 2024.

2. The City of Norwich (Southern Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order, 1982 (as amended) (hereinafter called the “1982 Order”) is amended as specified in Article 3 of this Order.
3. In Schedule 1 the reference to Christchurch Road is amended by the addition of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
