Emergency Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Dereham Road (CTRO1013) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to repairs of a burst water main the use by vehicles (of any class/specific class) of the Dereham Road (westbound only) from its junction with Sweet Briar Road roundabout for 100m westwards (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Guardian Road, Farrow Road, Colman Road, Mile End Road, Newmarket Road, A47 Through J A11/B1172 W, A47 Through J A11/B1172 E, Southern Bypass Keswick To Colney, A47 From J B1108 To J A11/B1172 E, A47 From J A11/B1172 To J B1108 W, A47 Through J B1108 E, A47 J B1108 Join E, Southern Bypass, A47 Through J B1108 W, A47 From J B1108 To J A1074 W, A47 From J A1074 To J B1108 E, A47 Through J A1074 E, A47 Through J A1074 W, Dereham Road (Norwich, Colney, Bawburgh, Little Melton, Cringleford, Hethersett, Costessey).

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood or danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 15th to 19th July 2024 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 4th August 2024 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 4th August 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

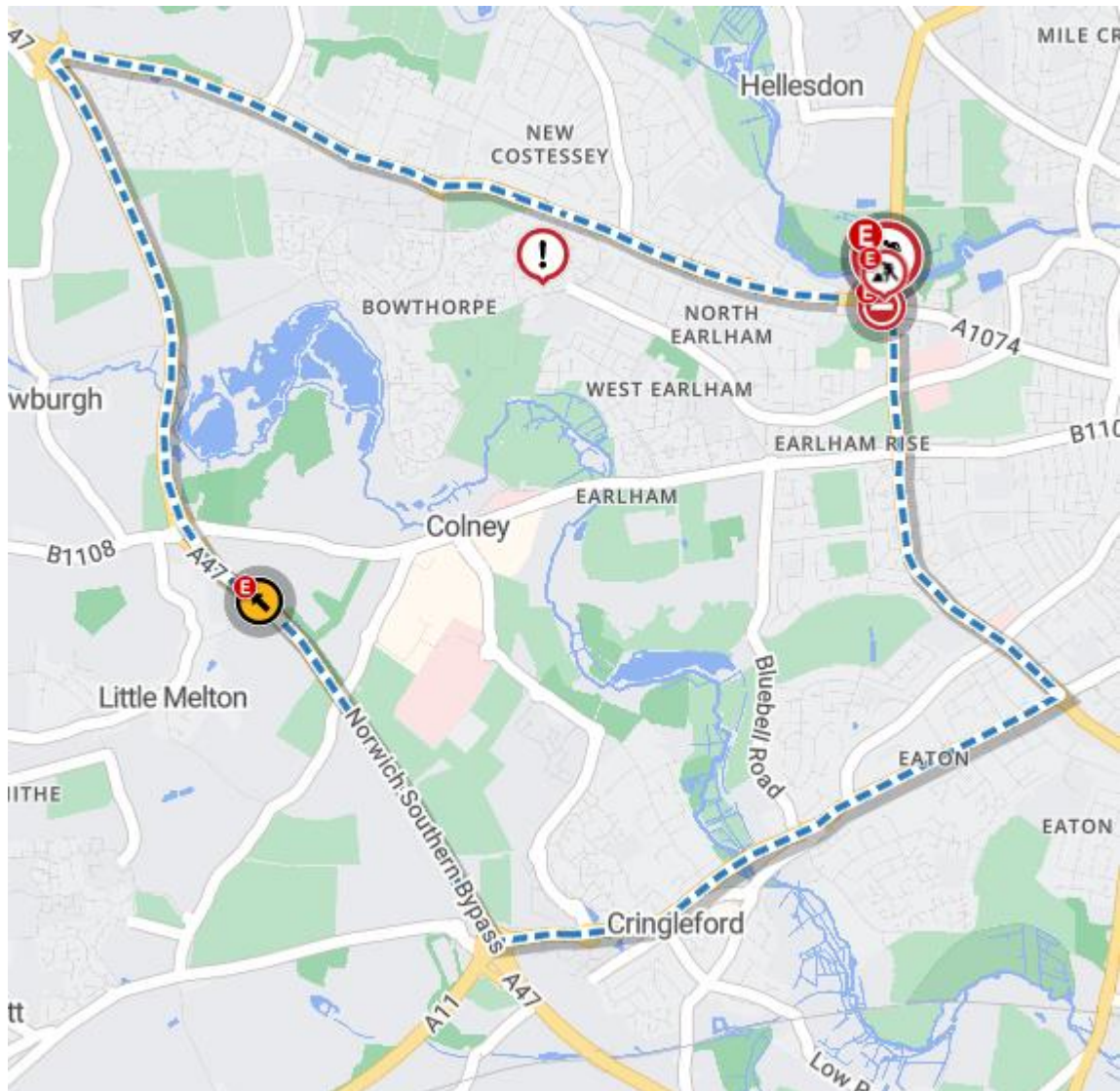

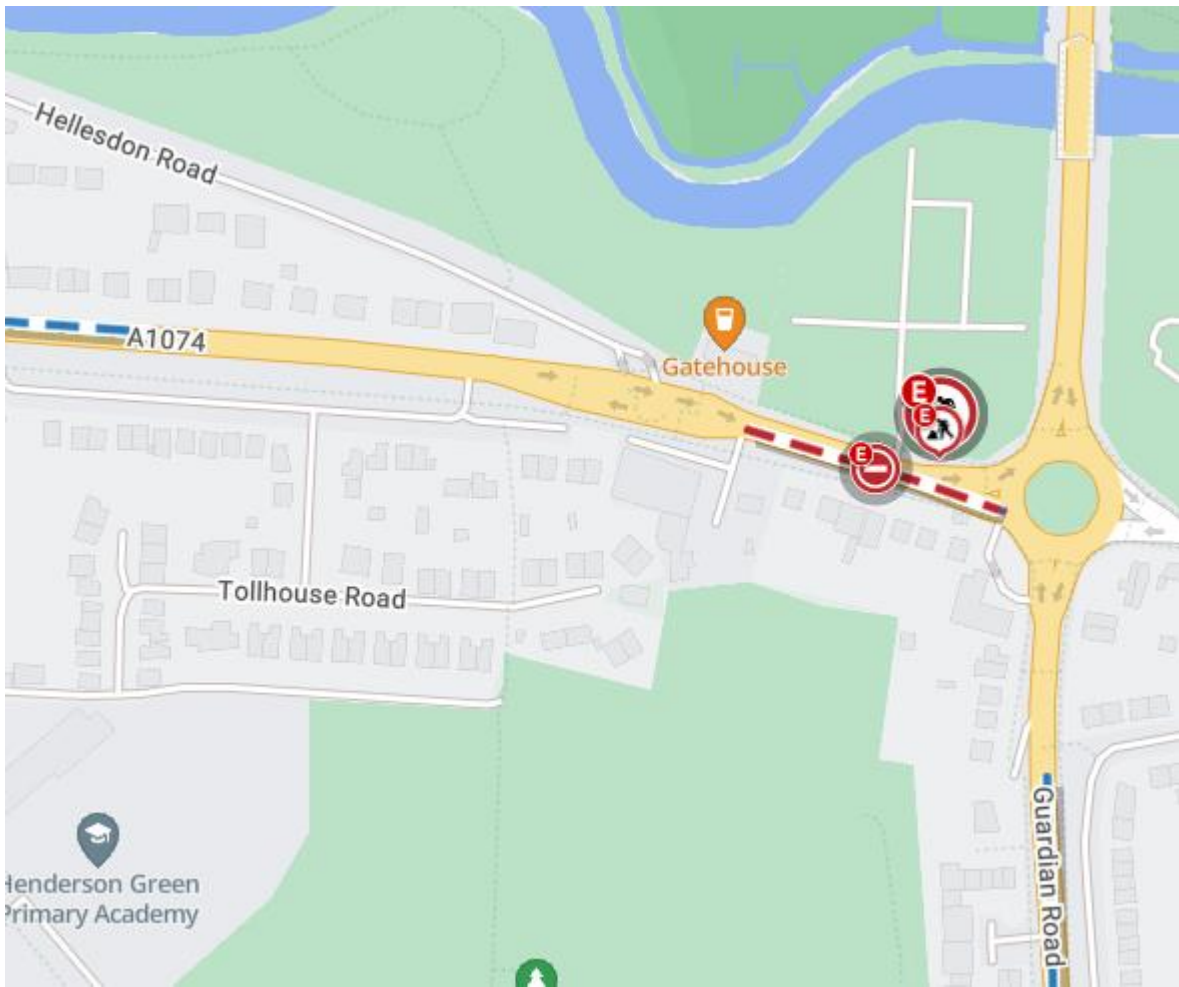
