## Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Gertrude Road) Emergency Continuation Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024 Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Gertrude Road (CTRO1022) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to repairs and investigation of subsidence the use by vehicles (of any class/specific class) of the Gertrude Road from its junction with Garrett Court for 20m eastwards (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be continue to be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood or danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place on the 21<sup>st</sup> August 2024 (previously 31<sup>st</sup> July to 20<sup>th</sup> August 2024) but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 21<sup>st</sup> August to 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024 or until the closure/restriction is/are no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

Alternative route is via: Gertrude Road, Sprowston Road, Silver Road, Mousehold Avenue, Lavengro Road and vice versa.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
