Temporary Restriction of Traffic Movement

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Woolworth Halloween Haunted House event, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the U71705 Bromedale Avenue from 5m south of its junction U71706 Poterbush Road to its junction with U71728 Ryefield Road in the PARISH OF MULBARTON.

The Order will come into effect on 31st October 2024 and will remain in force for 8 hours. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) from 16:00 to 23:59 on the 31st October 2024 for the duration of the event. Restriction on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed

Alternative route will be via: 71705 Bromedale Avenue, C194 Cuckoofield Lane


