## Norfolk County Council (Norwich, St Martin at Oak Wall Lane) Emergency Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, St Martin at Oak Wall Lane Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to emergency repairs to street lights the use by vehicles (of any class/specific class) of the St Martins At Oak Wall Lane from 35m east of its junction with Oak Street for 45m eastwards (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Alternative eastbound route – Oak Street, Sussex Street and St Augustines Street. Alternative westbound route - St Augustines Street, Aylsham Road, Wingfield Road and Oak Street.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024 to 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 20<sup>th</sup> January 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
