Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Judges Walk) Urgent Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Judges Walk (CTRO1175) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to urgent gulley repairs traffic (of any class) over Newmarket Road at its junction with Judges Walk (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily restricted from turning left and right on to Judges Walk.

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from between 07:00 and 16:00 on 17th February 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 21st February 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 17th February to 21st February 2025 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 21st February 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

Alternative route is via: Left Turn Restriction - Newmarket Road, Mile End Road, Unthank Road and Judges Walk: Right Turn Restriction - Newmarket Road, Unthank Road and Judges Walk.


A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
