Norfolk County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1061a) affecting the Waterloo Road from its junction with Angel Road to its junction with Albany Road ("Road A") and Patteson Road (westbound) from its junction with Aylsham Road to its junction with Aylsham Road to its junction with Angel Road (southbound) from its junction with Aylsham Road to its junction with Angel Road ("Road C") and Angel Road from its junction with Patteson Road to its junction with Eade Road ("Road D") in the City of Norwich to facilitate Norfolk County Council reconfiguration works on junction, the Roads A and B will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) and the Roads C and D will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload for the duration of the works/period the closure/restriction is necessary which is anticipated to be from 18th November 2024 to 16th March 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 17th May 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: A) Waterloo Road, Magpie Road, Magalen Road, Esdelle Street, Edward Street, St Augustines Street and B) Aylsham Road and Waterloo Road.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A-D where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 17th May 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
