Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Wellington Lane) Emergency Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich Wellington Lane (CTRO1222) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to emergency electrical fault works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Wellington Lane from 40m north of its junction with Pottergate for 30m northwards (the "Road A") and Wellington Lane from its junction with Pottergate to its junction with St Benedicts Street in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/suspension. Traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road A will be temporarily prohibited and the Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the one-way system (eastbound) to allow vehicles to travel in both a easterly and westerly direction.

Alternative route is via: St Swithins Road, Westwick Street, Barn Road, Grapes Hill, Cleveland Road, St Giles Street, Willow Lane, Cow Hill and Pottergate.

The closure/suspension is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the roads A-B or both.

The closure/suspension is anticipated to take place from 2nd to 7th April 2025 but the Roads A-B may continue to be closed/suspended until the 22nd April 2025 where the closure/suspension is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/suspension is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 22nd April 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

The works promoter for this suspension/closure is: UK Power Network.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the suspension/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
